9 am – 10.00am – Welcome & Introduction to Working Equitation International USA (WEIAUSA). We will talk about the elements of working equitation, a very brief history to put things into perspective and followed by a verbal outline of the levels of classes in dressage and the obstacles. Benefits of Working Equitation to every horse and rider, regardless of level, breed, aspiration, level of competence.
